Coming to terms with the Bible

Read the following verses

- X 2 Timothy 3:16
 - X Hebrews 3:7 (vv 7-11 is a quote from Psalm 95:7-11)
 - X Hebrews 10:15 (vv 16,17 are quotes from Jeremiah 31:33,34)
- What do these verses tell us about the Bible?

Read Psalm 19

In the light of this morning's talk, and the passages you have just read, discuss these questions:

- X You may well have heard it said "We are not under Law but under Grace". So, when you read something from the books of the Law can you just ignore it?
- X Do we even need to read the Law stuff (eg Leviticus), can we just ignore that part of the Bible?
- X "*the testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple.*" (Ps 19:7). When you say "I believe the Bible" (if you do!) what do *you* mean?
- X Can you share times when you have found reading the Bible *converted your soul, made you wise, rejoiced your heart, or enlightened your eyes?*
- X The Words of God. Gold/money. Which do you desire more?
