GRACE STUDIES: Esther

When Esther was taken to King Ahasuerus in his royal palace in the tenth month, which is the month of Tebeth, in the seventh year of his reign, the king loved Esther more than all the other women; of all the virgins she won his favour and devotion, so that he set the royal crown on her head and made her queen instead of Vashti. Esther 2: 16-17

Have you ever received an opportunity to do something out of the blue? Something that you haven't worked for, or tried for?

Esther was a Jew, she was not from a family of influence. She was an orphan and was adopted by a relative, Mordecai, who supported and encouraged her. She was admired by all who saw her, including king Ahasuerus. He made her queen.
