Wednesday...

Thursday.... Choose one verse from Chapter Two and *learn it off by heart*. 15 minutes

Friday.... If there is something in the chapter you don't understand, write your question in the Whatsapp group. If there is something that you have gone "Wow" or "That's great" about in this chapter, *underline it* in your Bible carefully. Also make sure you can still say the verse you learnt yesterday 15 minutes

<u>Saturday</u>.... Go to john.lumin.org.uk and click the audio download link to get the audio file and listen to the discussion there on John Chapter 1. Also check to see if anyone has answered your question from yesterday on WhattsApp (or try to answer someone else's!). *45 minutes*

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Memorising Verses...some ideas

1/ Set it to music and sing it to yourself...include the reference in the song so you can find the verse easily (or use the ones already set to music on www.walkingbible.org)

2/ Write it out on a card ... with reference on reverse. Read one side of the card then try to say what is on the other side without looking. For instance, if you read the reference say the verse, if you read the verse say the reference

3/ Record the verse and play it back regularly. Also record it with some words missing, and fill these words in when you say it back

4/ Repeat...repeat...repeat!

Why Memorise Bible Verses?

Because they are good for you (see 2 Timothy 3:16)

Because they help you overcome temptation, ...as they did for Jesus...see Matthew chapter 4

Because God speaks to us through the Bible, and verses we know by heart are often the ones He uses
